42nd ANNUAL NILE STOCK SHOW ACCEPTING ENTRIES

Billings, Mont. - The Northern International Livestock Exposition (NILE) is now taking entries for the 2009 NILE Stock Show. This year the NILE will feature eleven cattle breed shows as well as shows for junior fed in swine, lamb, and steers, club calf, and a range cattle pen show. New this year will be the feature of an All Breeds Select Sale on Wednesday, Oct. 14th, that is open to cattle from all breeds and will also include a special section for the Montana Shorthorn Association.

In addition to the All Breeds Select Sale, the NILE features special cattle breed sales throughout the week. Breeds that will have sales will be Gelbvieh, Red Angus, and Black Angus. All sales will feature some of the top genetically bred cattle for each respective breed.

In addition to the cattle breed shows, the Jr. Fed Show will be on Monday, Oct. 12th with the sale on the following day. The NILE Club Calf Show will be held on Wednesday, Oct. 14th, with the highly anticipated sale the following day.

Entries for all cattle shows and youth shows are due September 15th, with late entries postmarked by September 26th.
