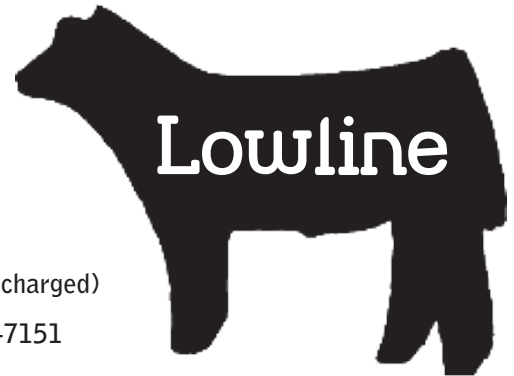


# 2011 American Lowline Angus Show

- All animals must be recorded in the name of the exhibitor prior to the NILE show. A copy of the registration paper, an affidavit of registration, or a copy of registration application must accompany each entry to the show. There will be a Fullblood Show and a Percentage/Purebred (1/2, 3/4, 7/8, etc.) show. Fullblood bulls and fullblood females will show in separate classes from the percentage and purebred bulls and females, who will show together in their appropriate classes. Group classes can contain both percentage or purebred and fullbred cattle in the same group and will compete against each other.
- Proof of satisfactory semen evaluation for bulls born prior to September 1, 2009 will be submitted at the time of check-in.
- Cattle must be entered and exhibited under the recorded ownership at the time of the show entry deadline. Jointly owned animals must be entered and shown under the multi-ownership (all co-owners) in the individual classes.
- All animals must be properly tattooed, including herd prefix, and will be inspected at the show. Tattoo must be legible and must match registration papers.
- All bulls born before September 1, 2010 must show with a nose lead. The right to disqualify from the show any animal deemed unmanageable is reserved by the show committee.
- All cattle must meet the health requirements set out by the show management. Any deviation will be just cause for immediate disqualification from the show.
- All females born before September 1, 2009 must be shown with a calf at side. All females born September 1, 2009 to April 30, 2010 must be accompanied by a verification of pregnancy signed by a licensed veterinarian. Exception to the rule of safe in calf will apply to: 1) a donor female that has produced fertile eggs in the previous twelve (12) months as verified in a written statement from a licensed veterinarian/embryologist or 2) females shown with calf at side.
- All females shown in the cow/calf classes with a calf over 150 days must be bred back and must be accompanied by a verification of pregnancy signed by a licensed veterinarian. Exception to the safe in calf rule will apply to a donor female that has produced eggs in the previous twelve (12) months as verified by a written statement from a licensed veterinarian/embryologist.
- Calf at side in the cow/calf classes must not exceed 240 days, be nursing, and be her natural born calf (not an embryo calf born to another recipient).

- Any person found guilty of misrepresentation, or not abiding by the show rules, will be disqualified and denied the privilege of showing.
- Classes will be designated after entries are received (postmarked on or before September 30, 2011). Any of the classes designated may be split if classes become too large, at the discretion of show management. If three or less entries are in a class, classes will be combined. The American Lowline Registry will accept additional group classes provided by the specific shows (pair of calves, pair of bulls, etc.) Any questions regarding class designations should be referred to the breed superintendent listed above. Classes will be judged with each class made up on no more than 10 (ten) head. Percentage females will be judged first, followed by fullblood females, percentage bulls, fullblood bulls.

#### Premiums & Awards:

See page 18 for monetary premiums. Grand champion bull and grand champion female will receive NILE jackets. Reserve grand champion bull and female will receive a NILE vest. Genex Hawkeye West will award a \$150 certificate for semen collection to the grand champion bull.

- 12. Senior Get of Sire - Four animals by one sire shown in the above lots. Both sexes represented. Fullblood or percentage.\*\*
- 13. Produce of Dam - Two animals by one dam shown in the above lots.\*\*
- 14. Breeder, Best Six Head - Exhibitor must be the breeder of the animals exhibited in the above lots.\*\*

**To participate in showmanship, the animal must be entered in the show.**

**There is no charge for showmanship.**

- 15. Pee Wee Showmanship - 8 years of age and under\*\*
- 16. Junior Showmanship - 9-13 years of age\*\*
- 17. Intermediate Showmanship - 14-17 years of age\*\*
