Classes will be divided into 2 equal classes with natural age breaks considered if classes have 10 or more animals entered. This show is subject to the Northern International Livestock Expo General Rules and Regulations, and to the Special Rules of this section. Where Special Rules conflict with other rules, Special Rules prevail.

- Entries must be registered with the American Hereford Association. Animals with 'pending' or 'applied for' registration are not eligible to show.
- Entries are subject to provisions and rules for showing as set forth by the AHA Board of Directors and are subject to supervision of the show and sale committee representing the MHBA.
- All exhibitors must be current members of the MHBA in order to be eligible to show.
- All entries will be measured. Maximum height to be shown in these classes is 45 inches on mature females and 48 inches on mature bulls. Any animal exceeding the height limit will not be eligible to show.
- All horned and polled Miniature Hereford cattle will show together.
- Any animal without a legible tattoo will not be eligible to show.

## Premiums & Awards:

See page 18 for monetary premiums. Grand champion bull and grand champion female to receive NILE jackets. Reserve grand champion bull and female to receive a NILE vest. Genex Hawkeye West will award a \$150 certificate for semen collection to the grand champion bull.
