NILE ProRodeo Action Rolls into Billings

BILLINGS, MONT - The Northern International Livestock Exposition (NILE) will feature five nights of quality family entertainment at one of the largest ProRodeo events in Montana Wednesday, October 13 through Saturday, October 16 at 7 p.m. The rodeo will be held in the Expo Center Arena at Metra Park in Billings. Each night fans will be entertained by Barrelman, JJ Harrison and Rodeo Announcer, Wayne Brooks. New to the NILE this year, Brookman Rodeo will serve as stock contractor along with additional providers Smith ProRodeo, Burch Rodeo and Silverado Rodeo.

Thursday's performance, "Wrangler National Patriots Night" is presented by Wrangler. Military personnel may receive tickets to the performance for half-off the regular price with military ID.

Friday Night is "Tough Enough to Wear Pink" night presented by St. Vincent Health care. This annual event brings awareness to the reality of breast cancer and raises money to assist in breast cancer research and screenings. The NILE will pledge \$1 for every rodeo ticket purchased and the money will be donated towards the Eva Project.

NILE ProRodeo ticket prices are as follows:

Wednesday and Thursday: \$13 general admission and \$23 reserved seating if purchased in advance; \$15 for general admission and \$25 reserved admission the day of the event.

Friday and Saturday: \$15 general admission and \$28 reserved seating purchased in advance; \$17 and \$30 the day of the event. Discounted general admission tickets for kids and seniors are \$9.50 nightly. Family 4-packs of tickets may be purchased for \$39-\$51.
